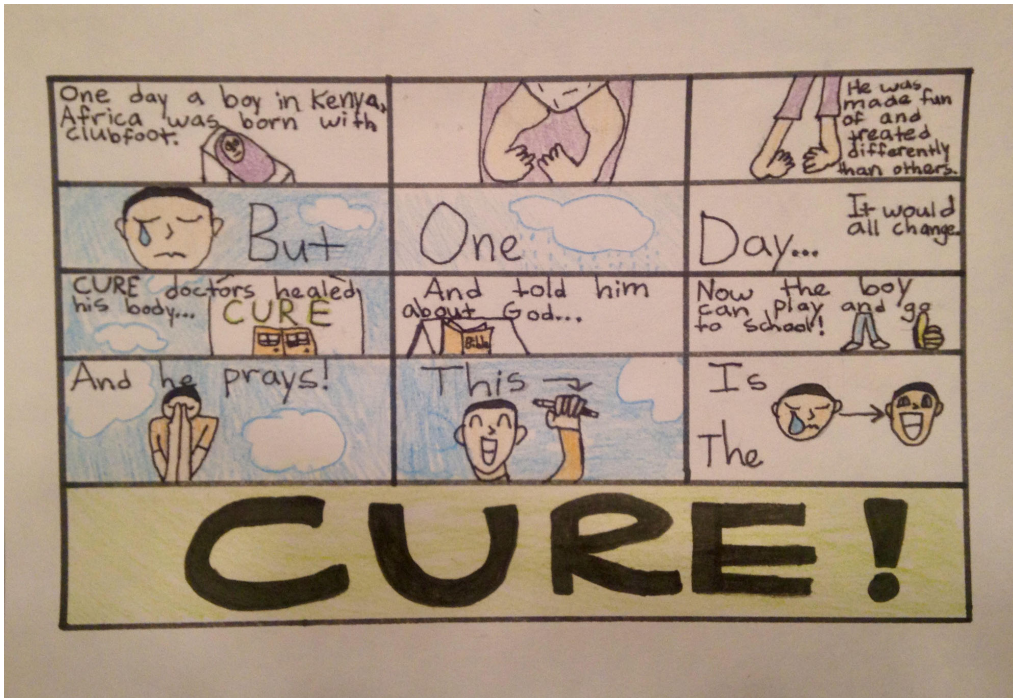


# Nashville student completes project on CURE

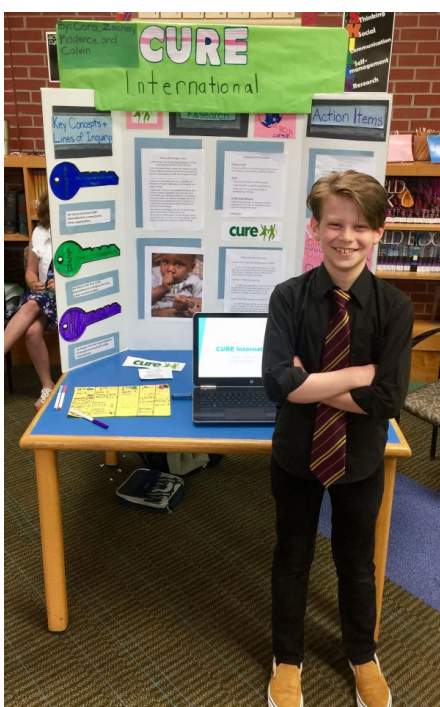

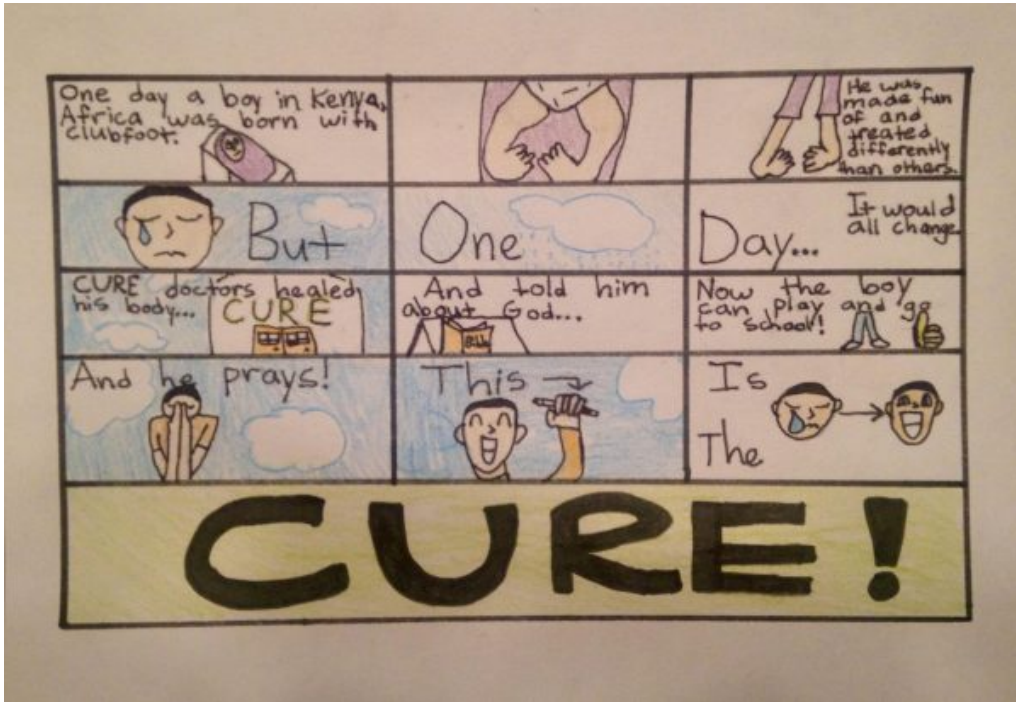
