[The Tebow CURE Hospital](#) in Davao City, Philippines, has become a source of hope and healing for thousands of people. Now seven years old, the hospital has earned a record of impact that is truly worthy of celebration.

Tebow CURE has delivered excellent medical care and thoughtful ministry to the children of the Philippines. In 2020, the hospital was selected from 89 hospitals in 16 countries to receive the ‘Excellence Award for Community Involvement’ at the Hospital Management Asia Awards.

Equally astounding are the medical results of the past seven years: 5,025 surgical procedures performed on children with treatable conditions like clubfoot, cleft lip and palate, and disabilities resulting from chronic burn contractures. In a typical year, more than 1,000 life-changing reconstructive plastic and orthopedic surgeries are performed.

CURE leverages its locations and expertise in under-resourced countries to help expand access to healthcare. Over the past seven years, Tebow CURE has trained more than 290 health professionals. Through training, CURE’s reach is extended, creating more access to surgery for more children in need. Most importantly, the hospital stewards its platform to share the love and hope of Jesus with patients, parents, and the communities it serves.

“We have accomplished so much in the past seven years, and by the grace of God, we look forward to many more years of collaboration with our partners to benefit the children of the Philippines.
