

cure international is a Christian nonprofit organization operating a global network of eight children's hospitals that offer free pediatric surgical interventions for children living with treatable disabilities. CURE Children's Hospitals provide life-changing care for children suffering from cleft lip/palate, neglected clubfoot, bowed legs, burn contractures, spina bifida, brain tumors, and hydrocephalus.

The 501(c)(3) was founded in 1996 to meet the massive need for pediatric healthcare in Kenya. Since then, CURE has expanded its footprint several times to bring hope and healing to even more children. In 2014, CURE International expanded to Southeast Asia when it partnered with the Tim Tebow Foundation to open a CURE hospital in the Philippines. CURE's newest hospital opened in April of 2021 in Zimbabwe.

The organization's global neurological program, CURE Neuro, is based at the CURE Uganda Children's Hospital and serves as a world-renowned center for the treatment of hydrocephalus & spina bifida. CURE International multiplies its impact by providing clinical training at many hospitals with the intention of producing a new generation of local healthcare professionals.
