Dr. Rick Gardner is the Chief Medical Officer (CMO) of **CURE International**, a Christian NGO with over 1,100 employees that operates a global network of eight pediatric hospitals to provide surgical care for children living with treatable disabilities such as cleft palates and bowed legs.

As CMO, Dr. Gardner is responsible for the medical care at all CURE hospitals and actively participates on the CURE Executive Leadership Team. He also serves as an orthopedic surgeon at CURE Children's Hospital of Zimbabwe.

Dr. Gardner has been with CURE since 2009 and has previously served at the Beit-CURE International Hospital in Malawi and the CURE Children's Hospital of Ethiopia.

In December 2020, Dr. Gardner was recognized by the Ethiopian Ministry of Health for his outstanding contributions to the growth of orthopedic treatment in that country.

Dr. Gardner frequently lectures at international conferences, publishes medical research literature, and participates with his COSECSA and SICOT colleagues to improve health outcomes for underserved people around the world.
