

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – HOSTING *DISCOVER CURE*

1. Is this a fundraiser or donation event?

No. *Discover CURE* gatherings are intentionally designed with no financial ask. The goal is simply to introduce others to the heart of CURE's mission through stories and conversation.

2. What do I need to provide as a host?

You provide the space and the food. This could be brunch, lunch, dinner, or refreshments—whatever feels natural to you.

3. How many people should I invite?

The ideal group is 8 to 12 people, including you (and your spouse or other family members, if applicable) and our facilitator. Enough for a good conversation, but still personal and relaxed.

4. How long is the event?

Roughly two hours. That includes a welcome, food, five short videos, discussion prompts, and time to linger or ask questions. It's relaxed and conversational—not rushed.

5. What if I'm nervous about inviting people?

That's totally normal. We'll support you every step of the way, including helping you think through who to invite and providing a sample message you can send. You don't need to "sell" anything—just invite people into something meaningful.

6. Who facilitates the conversation?

A trained CURE facilitator (not the host) will guide the night, handle transitions between videos, and create space for dialogue. Your role is simply to welcome your guests and enjoy the evening alongside them.

7. What technology is needed?

Just a screen big enough for everyone to see and hear the short video stories clearly. We'll work with you ahead of time to make sure it all works smoothly.

8. What kind of people should I invite?

In the end, we're looking to discover more people just like you. So think of those you believe might fall in love with the mission—people you know to be curious, openhearted, and generous.
