

DISCOVER CURE FACILITATOR SCRIPT

Total Duration: 75–90 minutes (flexible based on host setup)

Pre-Event Setup (Facilitator)

- Arrive 15–20 minutes early to:
 - ▶ Test HDMI or screen connection
 - ▶ Load and cue videos
 - ▶ Confirm meal timing and seating with host
- Have all five videos ready to play in order on your device

Host Welcome & Opening (5 min)

Host:

- Welcome everyone and thank them for coming.
- Briefly share your personal connection to CURE (1 minute).
- Say something like: "We're so glad you're here to learn about something that means a lot to us."
- Open with a short prayer.
- Introduce the facilitator: "Tonight we're joined by [Facilitator's Name], a member of the CURE team. They'll guide us through this experience and help us learn more about the mission. Thanks again for being here."

Facilitator Introduction & Group Guidelines (10 min)

Facilitator:

- Thank the host for opening their home (or space).
- Share personal background: where you live, family, interests.
- "Tonight is meant to be relaxed and reflective. There's no ask, no pressure—just a chance to learn and engage with something that many of us find deeply meaningful."
- Ask each guest to briefly share:
 - ▶ Their name
 - ▶ How they know the hosts

Group Guidelines:

"To help create a safe, respectful space, we ask everyone to keep in mind a few simple agreements:

- Use *I* statements rather than *you* or *we* statements.
- Please don't offer advice or try to 'fix' anything others share.
- Keep phones away during our time together.
- Respect confidentiality (what's shared here, stays here)."

Tone Setting + Practical Info:

"We'll watch five short videos throughout the evening—each one's about five minutes. After each video, we'll pause for a few moments of conversation. We'd love to hear what stands out to you. This isn't a lecture—it's a conversation."

"We'll get started in about 5 minutes. Feel free to top off your drink or use the restroom now so we can all settle in together."

- Let guests know when dinner will happen (*choose either option A [dinner before video 1] or option B [dinner after video 3] below*).

Video 1 (5 min)

Facilitator transition into video:

"We're going to begin by watching the first short film. It introduces the reality facing many children around the world—kids who live with treatable conditions but don't have access to surgery. Let's watch together."

Discussion Questions:

1. What stood out to you from the video?
2. What emotions did you feel as you watched it?

Video 2 (5 min)

Facilitator transition into video:

"This next video goes a little deeper—not just into what's physically happening for these children, but what it means for their relationships, education, and future. Let's take a look."

Discussion Questions:

1. What struck you about their experience?
2. How might this shape a child's sense of identity or future?

Video 3 (5 min)

Facilitator transition into video:

"Now that we've looked at the challenge and its impact, this next video introduces CURE—the work we do and why we do it. It's where the story begins to change."

Facilitator Reflection (2–3 min):

- After the video, share why you chose to work at CURE.
- Tell a meaningful story or insight that shaped your passion.

Discussion Questions:

1. Any thoughts or reactions after seeing that?
2. What surprised you about what CURE does? (Optional if discussion feels natural.)

Dinner Break (15–20 min)

Choose one:

- Option A: Dinner before video 1 (if event starts early)
- Option B: Dinner after video 3 (if later start or lighter food)

"This is a great time to pause, share a meal, and continue the conversation. Feel free to keep reflecting on what we've seen so far."

If applicable:

"Restrooms are [location]. We'll plan to start the next video in about 20 minutes."

Video 4 (5 min)

Facilitator transition into video:

"This next film gives us a closer look at the healing that's happening through CURE—not just medically, but relationally and spiritually. You'll see what restored hope can look like."

Discussion Questions:

1. What gives you hope in this?
2. What connections do you see between physical healing and spiritual healing?

Video 5 (5 min)

Facilitator transition into video:

"We'll close our time with one final video. It's a picture of what's ahead—the dream and vision of where CURE is going and the kind of impact we're praying for."

- No discussion after this video
- Let the video speak for itself

Facilitator Closing Prayer (1–2 min):

"God, thank You for the work You're doing in the lives of children and families around the world. Thank You for Your healing and restoration in our lives too. May we continue to be people caught up in awe of You—our Creator and the Great Healer. Amen."

Closing Thanks (2 min)

Facilitator:

- Thank guests for giving their evening to learn about CURE.
- "We're so grateful you took time to be here. Some of you might really resonate with what you've seen tonight. For others, this may simply have been a meaningful evening of learning. Either way, we're honored."
- Mention that you'll follow up individually to continue the conversation, if they're open to it.
- Thank the host(s) again for making the evening possible.
"Whether this is the beginning of a journey with CURE or simply a onetime connection, thank you for being part of it."

Guests are free to linger, ask questions, or head out.
